IMPORTANT WEEKLY CLEANING ROUTINE FOR 'SCOTSMAN' SELF CONTAINED FLAKER ICE MACHINES

1. Turn machine off at the mains electrical supply.

2. Empty the ice bin. (If it is not convenient to discard the ice, you can transfer the ice to a freezer using a clean plastic bag as a container).

3. Using the correct 'PPE', mix 5 litres of clean water with 500ml of Scotsman Sanitizer antibacterial cleaner and, using disposable cloth, wipe down the bin inside and out making sure to reach out of the way areas.

DO NOT RINSE OR DRY !!

NOTE - The solution is odourless and tasteless. Wiping dry may well re-contaminate.

4. Pour half a litre of the anti-bacterial solution into the bin's drain to keep it clean and clear of Obstruction or any bacterial build-up.

5. Soak the ice scoop and any other ice utensils in the remaining solution for up to 90 minutes.

6. Slide out the air filter (if fitted) and remove any dust build-up before replacing.

7. Close bin door and turn machine on to return to normal operation.

NOTE – Flaker units will have a 3 minute delay prior to the ice making mode beginning


